### Problem Statement

- Health & Safety: Conduct counseling on hygiene, sanitation, and disease prevention.
- Preparedness: Train vulnerable families in disaster readiness and community-based resilience strategies.

- Dignity & Stability: Support families to recover with dignity, reducing vulnerabilities during future crises.
